Well, another year and another attempt from Congress to decrease Medicare physician payments. A cut of 3.4% went into effect on January 1st, and that is on top of a 2% cut in 2023. This affects all reimbursement as the private insurers set their payments based on what Medicare reimburses. And more importantly this adversely affects patient care. Congress can intervene to stop these cuts moving forward by passing H.R. 6683, the Preserving

Seniors' Access to Physicians Act. I am asking you to contact your Congressional representative and urge them to quickly pass H.R. 6683. <u>This link</u> will allow you to tell your story and urge your Congressperson to stop these cuts from harming our patients.

Dutchess County Behavior & Community Health Commissioner's Corner

Please save the date for our third (!) Annual Duchess County Health Fair which will be held at Dutchess Community College on April 13 from 11am to 2pm. Would you or your organization like to participate? We will consider exhibits or presentations that involve public health and health-positive topics—robust content, originality,

and the ability to capture the public's attention will be prioritized. We will be preferentially selecting exhibitors who will feature engaging and original health-positive demonstrations, onsite offerings and screenings, and entertainment. The fair will feature a "scavenger hunt" to encourage the public to visit a wide variety of booths, and a raffle—perhaps your organization can donate suitable items or services as raffle prizes. There will be a sensory-friendly area as we welcome attendees of all abilities. Please note that we may not be able to accommodate all applicants based on time or space constraints. In the wake of rising rates of sexually transmitted infections (STIs), expedited partner treatment (EPT) has emerged as a tool to control transmission. EPT involves writing a prescription or dispensing medication to a patient with an STI for the purpose of treating their sexual contact(s) without them having to necessarily seek care independently. In addition to treating the index patient themselves, EPT allows for them to deliver a prescription or medication to the partner(s) directly. NYSDOH is reporting that in Dutchess County, EPT is offered to less than 10 percent of STI patients on average. I urge you to learn more about EPT and offer it to your patients.

Please be aware that as we face increases in respiratory illness caused by viruses such as influenza, COVID, or RSV, we should also be looking out for presentations of bacterial illness including pertussis (whooping cough). Outbreaks of pertussis, a vaccinepreventable illness caused by the bacterium Bordetella pertussis, have been identified in nearby Suffolk and Nassau Counties. Considering testing for pertussis in the right clinical scenario may help us gauge the degree to which transmission may be occurring locally in Dutchess County, and provide appropriate antibiotic treatment where indicated. In the first week or so of infection, pertussis is largely indistinguishable from common viral infections, but cough in pertussis tends to worsen rather than improve over the second week and can continue for 6-10 weeks. Other characteristic features include cough paroxysms, episodes of apnea, or "whooping"; post-tussive vomiting is a telltale sign. Testing consists of pertussis PCR via nasopharyngeal swab (Dacron or rayon swab only). Nasopharyngeal samples can also be sent for culture, which is more specific; however, its sensitivity is low, and worsens both over time and with antibiotic therapy. Individuals with pertussis are considered contagious from the start of the catarrhal phase through 21 days after onset of paroxysms (or 5 days after starting antibiotic therapy.)
